Notice is hereby given that the Planning Commission and the Council of the City of McLoud, Oklahoma, will conduct a public hearing on an application for a REZONING and LOT SPLIT of the following described tract of land from A2 to RESIDENTIAL within the city limits of McLoud:

A tract of land in the NW/4 of Section 21, T 11N, R2E of the Indian Meridian, Pottawatomie County, Oklahoma, more particularly described as beginning at a point 1308.45 feet East of the NW/C of said Section 21; thence South 999 feet; thence East 218.07 feet; thence North 999 feet, thence West 218.07 feet to the point of beginning. Present use is A2, proposed for single family dwelling(s). (Conrad Court and Redskin Road)

Tract 1: A tract of land in the NW/4 of Section 21, T 11N, R2E beginning at a point 1308.45 feet East of NW/C of Section 21; thence South 250 feet; thence East 218.07; thence North 250 feet; thence 218.07 feet West to the point of beginning, (1.25 ac mol).

Tract 2: A tract of land in the NW/4 of Section 21, T 11N, R2E, beginning at a point 1308.45 East of NW/C of Section 21; thence south 250 feet starting point, thence South 250 feet; thence East 218.07 feet; thence 218.07 feet West to the point of beginning, (1.25 ac mol).

Tract 3: A tract of land in the NW/4 of Section 21, T 11N, R2E, beginning at a point 1308.45 East of NW/C of Section 21; thence South 500 feet starting point, thence South 499 feet; thence East 218.07 feet; thence North 499 feet; thence 218.07 feet West to point of beginning, (2.5 ac mol).

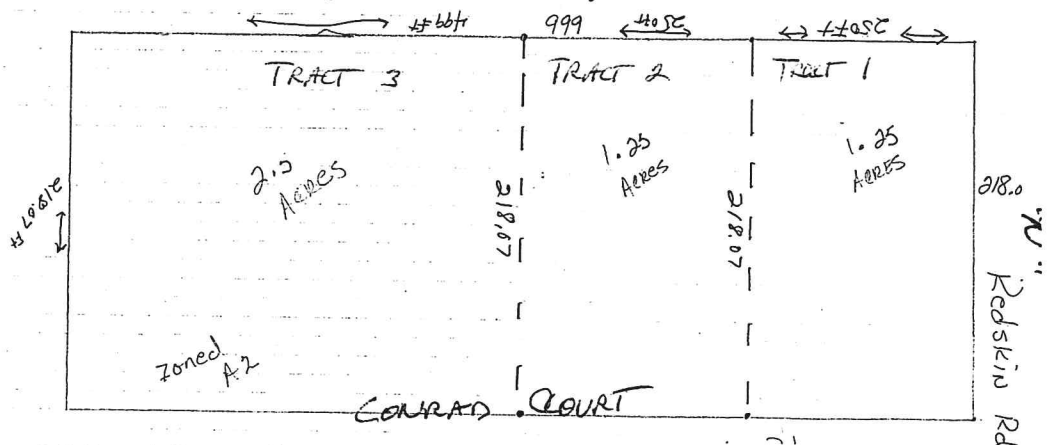
