**RESIDENTIAL GARAGE / YARD SALES
HANDOUT**

3-4-2:

No person shall hold, conduct, engage in, or participate in any manner in, a residential sale without a license.

A separate license shall be required for each location at which a residential sale is to be held. No location shall be eligible for more than one license in a sixty (60) day period, unless there has been a change in the ownership of such location, or unless license for such locations have been issued to nonprofit organizations, associations or corporation may be issued more than such license in any sixty (60) day period.

3-4-4

The city clerk is authorized to grant a license for a residential sale for a period not to exceed three consecutive days to any person applying.

Inability To Hold Sale; Reissuance Of License: If a residential sale is not held on the dates for which the license is issued or is terminated during the first day of the sale because of inclement weather conditions, and an affidavit by the license holder to this effect is submitted the city clerk may issue another license to the applicant for a residential sale to be conducted at the same location within thirty (30) days from the date when the first sale was to be held.

Before issuing a residential sale license, the city clerk or city administrator may conduct such investigation as may reasonably be necessary to determine if there is compliance with this chapter (1987 Code § 9-304)

3-4-5

There is hereby levied a fee for residential sale licenses. The amount of the fee shall be as set by the city council by motion or resolution.

3-4-6

No person shall hold, conduct, engage in or participate in any manner or allow a residential sale to be held or conducted on premises under the control ownership more than one time in any sixty (60) day period; subject however, to the exceptions allowed in the sections 3-4-2 and 3-4-4 of this chapter (1987 Code § 9-307)

3-4-7

Number of Signs Allowed:

Signs advertising residential sales shall be limited to the two (2) signs and stakes issued by the city with the permit. Persons conducting residential sales are not authorized to post other signs or notices of the sale. Signs advertising residential sales shall not be placed in public easements. The city clerk or designated person is hereby authorized to adopt such further regulations or restrictions as shall be reasonably necessary to enforce these restrictions. (Ord. 2012-10, 10-18-2012)

Removal of Signs:

All signs must be removed no later than twenty four (24) hours following the conclusion of sale. (1987 Code § 9-308)

3-4-8

The sale area of any residential sale shall be confined to the premises for which the license has been issued, and in no event, shall articles or goods be displayed after the sale expiration date. (1987-Code § 9-309)
