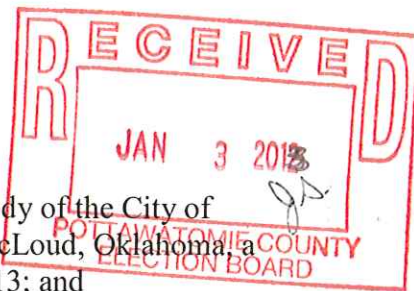


**CITY OF MCLLOUD NOTICE OF ELECTION
RESOLUTION NO. 2234**



BE IT RESOLVED, by the Statutory Council/Manager governing body of the City of McCloud, Oklahoma, that for the purpose of electing officers of the City of McCloud, Oklahoma, a nonpartisan general election, if needed, shall be held on Tuesday, April 2, 2013; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the filing period for electing council members of the City of McCloud shall begin at 8:00 a.m. on Monday, February 4, 2013, and close at 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, February 6, 2013, at the Pottawatomie County Election Board office located at 325 N. Broadway, Shawnee, Oklahoma.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the council members (except the at large member) of the City of McCloud must be a qualified elector residing in the ward they represent but shall be elected at large.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the following council members will be elected for four-year terms:

1. Council member - Ward Three (3), term expires year 2017.
2. Council member Ward Four (4), term expires year 2017

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the following council member will be elected to fill a two-year unexpired term:

1. Council member, Ward One (1), term expires year 2015

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a Council Member at large for a four-year term will be elected.

1. Council member, At Large, term expires year 2017.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that each candidate for office must be a qualified elector by virtue of being a resident and registered voter within the municipality for at least six (6) months prior to filing a declaration of candidacy, and if representing a ward, a resident in the ward to be represented at the time of candidacy and election.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that absentee ballots will be provided in accordance with State Law.
